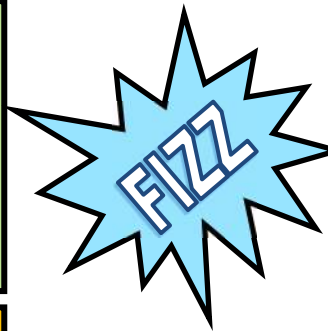

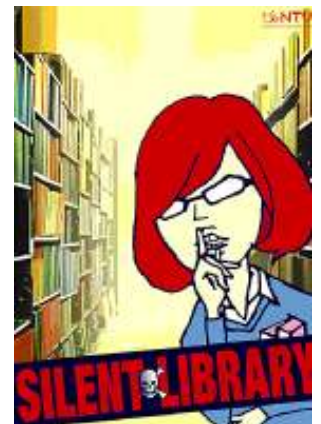


Teen Night at Puskarich Public Library
